Top 5 birds kept as pets

- Cockatiel
- African Grey
- Budgerigar (also commonly known as a budgie)
- Cockatoo
- Canary

Accessories

- bird cage
- feeder (water and seeds)
- cuttlebone
- perch
- toys (mirrors, ladders, swings and bells)

Grammar Focus - Conjunctions

Conjunctions are also called **connecting or joining words**. Conjunctions are words used to join phrases and sentences together or to show contrast (when two phrases or sentences are opposite).

Example

In the sentences below we use the conjunction **and** to join two sentences together and the conjunction **but** to show contrast.

I like parrots. I like canaries. I don't like cockatiels.

I like parrots and canaries but I don't like cockatiels.



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An easy way to remember the main 7 conjunctions is to remember the word FANBOYS

- **F** is for the conjunction for
- A is for the conjunction and
- N is for the conjunction nor
- B is for the conjunction but
- O is for the conjunction or
- Y is for the conjunction yet
- S is for the conjunction so

7 main conjunctions

- for (or because) for explaining why.
 When using "for" to join sentences always use a comma before the word. A comma is not needed when using the connecting word "because".
- and to join two phrases or sentences that are similar or the same together
- nor is used when using the word "neither" to show two contrasting negatives
- but to show contrast
- or to show an alternative
- yet to show contrast
- **so** to show the result or consequence

Reading Exercise

(Let's read the following sentences and then use **conjunctions** to join the two sentences together to make one sentence or to show the contrast between the two sentences that have opposite meanings)

I want an African Grey. I want to teach it to talk.

I want an African Grey, **for** I want to teach it to talk. I want an African Grey **because** I want to teach it to talk.



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I want to buy a bird cage. I want to buy some accessories.

I want to buy a bird cage and some accessories.

I don't want a big bird cage. I don't want a bird cage that is too small.

I want neither a big bird cage nor do I want one that's too small.

I want to buy bird toys. I can't afford to buy everything.

I want to buy bird toys but I can't afford to buy everything.

I want to buy a mirror. I want to buy a ladder. I can't afford both.

I either want to buy a mirror or a ladder as I can't afford both. (as is also a conjunction).

I am not a pet lover. I may consider having a bird as a pet.

I am not a pet lover yet I may consider having a bird as a pet.

My parents do not want me to have a pet. I can't have a parrot as a pet.

My parents do not want me to have a pet so I can't have a parrot as a pet






